PRUC Church Council Report January and February/March meetings 2024

Members continuing from the previous year's Council were Heather Schubert (now Acting Chair), Val Watkinson, Russell Sheldrick, Woody Lee and George Chin. Meng Kheng Tan was an apology.

The main focus of discussions during both meetings was on the financial status of our church. Carole Lyons (PRUC Financial Coordinator) attended the meetings and gave the financial reports - there was initially some confusion over figures given in January and these were corrected by Carole at the March meetings. It was clear that we are operating on a deficit budget and this will be outlined in more detail during the Congregational AGM to be held on March 24th. It has been confirmed that we need to increase our income and decrease expenses where possible. We have currently increased Hall hiring fees and are negotiation with Hooker's to increase property rents for Williamson Hall, The Cottage and the Sheds. The hiring fee for the Liberated Church of Christ who uses our Church on Sunday afternoons has also been increased.

Following Rev. Do Young Kim's resignation in October 2023, Synod has contracted a supply minister to PRUC - Rev. Jim Winn - who commenced a 3 month placement on February 1st. Sharon (our Administrator) and Heather have been meeting with Jim regularly on Thursday mornings to orient him to PRUC and its members. Jim is using his own phone number and email address and utilises the vestry office. Dates have been confirmed for his fortnightly Sunday services - and he has commenced visiting members. Rosters are now a little easier for Sharon to arrange for visiting preachers for the weekly services. As we have had no response as yet, to employing a permanent part time minister to replace Rev. Do Young Kim, we have commenced making arrangements to extend Rev. Jim Winn's

contract for another 3 months from the end of April to include May, June and July 2024.

Problems with homeless people establishing themselves on church property were experienced over Christmas and early in the New Year - but have now been resolved.

The major flood at the rear of the cark park experienced after a severe rainstorm late last year, was of major concern. Possible expensive solutions were considered but ultimately Noel Tiver volunteered to provide a low cost solution that is working well so far - but the real test will come in winter. The office printer ceased working recently and we are currently exploring either repairs or the purchase of a new one. The church email system in also causing Sharon some problems and we are negotiating with Steven Zhang to improve this or transfer to a new provider. Due to Sharon's increased work load due to ministerial changes, we are requesting Synod to increase her hours from 4 to 5 hours/week

The Manse is now empty and Jan Carpenter has reviewed repairs and renovations necessary before we can rent this out - until it is required by a potential new minister in the future. Indications are that this will prove rather costly and Carole is being kept aware of possible expenses. Bill, Val and other church members are being asked to help with minor repairs and in making necessary arrangements to have other work completed as quickly as possible. We have confirmed a family who will rent the property from the end of April - bringing in some welcome income. Elections for the 2024 Council will occur on March 24th and we currently have eight nominations for Council including elders as listed elsewhere - you will be asked to accept their nomination at the AGM

Don't forget to bring in your mugs with your Lenten offering on Easter Sunday!

Chairperson – although I plan to still remain on Council for another year. Thanks for your support over the last difficult 4-5 months after both Rev. Do Young Kim and Lesley Warner resigned from their key roles in the church at short notice late last year.

He has planted new churches for people with disabilities and established a coffee shop and meeting room in an office block that is remotely operated and carries Christian messages of Hope and Life.
